"The Cheongye Kwan is strongly committed to encouraging our members to take part in Martial Arts training, with the health, well-being and safety of each individual always as our paramount concern. We recommend levels of training dependent on age and ability, and expect our students to train within these boundaries."

To support our Health & Safety policy we are committed to the following duties:

Undertake regular, recorded risk assessments within the school premises and all activities undertaken by the association.

Create a safe environment by putting health & safety measures in place as identified by the assessment.

Ensure that all members are given the appropriate level of training and competition by regularly assessing individual ability dependant on age, maturity and development.

Ensure that all members are aware of, understand and follow the club's health & safety policy.

Appoint a competent club member to assist with health and safety responsibilities.

Ensure that normal operating procedures and emergency operating procedures are in place and known by all members.

Provide access to adequate first aid facilities, telephone and a qualified first aider at all times.

Report any injuries or accidents sustained during any school activity or whilst in the Dojang.

Ensure that the implementation of the policy is reviewed regularly and monitored for effectiveness.

The association has a duty to:

Take reasonable care for your own health & safety and that of others who may be affected by what we do or do not do.

Co-operate with the national guidelines on health & safety issues.

Correctly use all equipment provided by the association.

Not tamper with, or misuse anything provided by the training venue for our health, safety or welfare.

Members, Visitors and Students:

It is the responsibility of the school to ensure the Safety, Health and Welfare of the above persons whilst they are on the class premises.

Any restricted areas will be clearly defined and where necessary barriers installed. All Students have a responsibility to ensure such areas are respected.

Authorised visitors coming onto the premises will be advised by the class instructor of the Health and Safety Policy, but it is the visitor's responsibility to ensure that they are fully aware of the contents of the Policy Document.

All visitors must comply with the Health & Safety Policy documentation as requested.
